

## **GeoShanghai 2010 Tour Schedule to Shanghai World Expo Park**

- **Date:** June 6<sup>th</sup> (Sunday)
- **Departure Time:** 08:30 am
- **Departure Place:** Grand Central Hotel Shanghai (Address: No.505, Jiujiang Road)
- **Itinerary:** Depart from Grand Central Hotel for Expo Park by bus on 08:30 am. After arrival, enter the park by appointed group time and entrance gate. Free tour inside the park. Places interesting to see in the park include Theme Pavilion, also called as Rising Star of Science and Technology in the 21th century, Performance Center, Pavilions of different countries, and Enterprise Pavilion. Lunch & Dinner are exclusive, but dining places can be found in the park. Return transportation not provided, but multiple public transits can be found at the gates.

### **Important Notice:**

1. If you'd like to attend, please make your reservation for this tour at the registration desk no later than 17:00 on June 3<sup>rd</sup>. An unscheduled visit will not be possible.
2. Please arrive at the appointed meeting spot on time. Maximum number is 50 passengers per bus. Please be aware that you will be required to show your Delegate Card.
3. No guide service.
4. Group tickets & Single Entry ONLY. Group members shall enter into the Expo Park together by turn, any people miss the group entrance will be treated as giving up.
5. Operation time of the Expo Park is 9:00 ~ 24:00. Open hour of the pavilions is 9:30 ~ 22:30.
6. Visitors must go through ticket pre-check, security check and ticket verification before entering the park. Visitors with special admission tickets are required to present a valid ID at the time of ticket. Park administration reserves the right to ban the visitor from entering if he (she) refuses to go through security check.
7. Explosive, flammable, radioactive and other hazardous items as well as items prohibited by laws and regulations of the People's Republic of China are not allowed in the park. In addition, the following items are prohibited in the park:

- (i) bottled water, beverage, alcohol, or any other liquid; with the exception of milk products for babies and medications (liquid, gel) necessary to patients, both of which can be carried in by appropriate volume; multiple drinking fountains can be easily found throughout the park.
  - (ii) lighters, matches or other devices for ignition;
  - (iii) long-handled umbrellas and large luggage;
  - (iv) banners, posters, billboards, leaflets or any other advertising items;
  - (v) motorcycles, light motor vehicles, bicycles, electric bicycles, motorized wheelchairs, scooters, skateboards, roller-blades, or similar transportation tools, with the exception of baby strollers, and manual or electric wheelchairs;
  - (vi) pets, with the exception of guide dogs and other service animals;
  - (vii) delta wings, paragliders, hot air balloons, model airplanes, kites, or any other flying objects;
  - (viii) radio-controlled toys, walkie-talkies, or any other radio transmission equipments;
  - or
  - (ix) any other items that may upset other visitors, or cause body injury or property damage to other visitors, or disturb the public order or security within the Expo Park.
8. GeoShanghai Organizer will NOT provide lunch & dinner on June 6<sup>th</sup>. The average cost will be around RMB45/per person in park restaurants.

- (1) Expo taxi ---- Tel: 96822。  
Cost: From Expo Park to Grand Central Hotel is around RMB35 (Before 23:00).
  - (2) Metro Transportation  
Cost: Line 2 (East Nanjing Road Station), 10-min walk to Grand Central Hotel  
Line 8 (People's Square Station), 10-min walk to Grand Central Hotel.
